UNDERSTANDING/ NAVIGATING THE FLOORPLAN



- 2025 Floor Plan
- Booth sizes
- Service aisles
- Combining booths for islands and peninsulas
- No freight aisle
- IMPORTANT RULE: Booth width must be less than or equal to booth length for any booths larger than 600 sq. ft.
- Utilities

HOW TO PREPARE



- Practice navigating the <u>floor plan</u> ahead of time
- · Check availability the day before and hour before your selection
- Make a list of your top 3 choices, 15 minutes prior to your selection time

Note: Keep an eye on the floor plan **after** you select your space. NAFEM will not notify you if a competitor selects near you. We are happy to move you if you no longer like your booth space.

SPACE SELECTION DAY



- 1. Click on the zoom link to join our waiting room.
- 2. Our exhibits team will admit you based on your appointment time and will assign you to one of our team members to discuss and select your space.
- 3. Space confirmed and reflected on website within 1-2 minutes.
- 4. Email confirmation/invoice sent the week of Sept. 2.

Note: You may be in the Zoom waiting room for a few minutes if our team is finishing up an appointment with another company.



. Inline Booth




RULES & REGULATIONS – INLINE BOOTHS



FEBRUARY 26-28 · ATLANTA

- . Inline Booths
 - NAFEM requires exhibitors who manufacture walk-in coolers, refrigerators and freezers to purchase a booth with a depth of 15' (4.57m).




RULES & REGULATIONS – PENINSULA BOOTH

Hanging signs are permitted to a maximum height of 20' to the top of the sign




RULES & REGULATIONS – ISLAND BOOTH

- Prevent an onsite headache -- let us check your floor plan
- Detailed floor plan with dimensions required to submit to info@thenafemshow.org by Nov. 8 for:
 - Manufacturers with walk-in coolers, refrigerators and freezers
 - Peninsulas
 - · Islands
 - Companies with written booth violation notices from 2023

IMPORTANT DATES



- Aug. 19 21
 - Online space selection for companies with 200+ points
- Aug. 26 29
 - Online space selection for companies with less than 200 points
 - Associate Members
 - Non-Members
 - Companies that submitted their 50% payment after July 26 deadline
- Sept. 18
 - Exhibit Resource Center available
 - Exhibitor Registration and Exhibitor Services Manual accessible online

IMPORTANT DATES



- . Nov. 1
 - . Final 50% payment due
 - NAFEM keeps 25% of total booth fee for all space reductions or cancellations occurring between space selection and Nov. 1
 - After Nov. 1, full balance due on any reduced or cancelled booths

IMPORTANT DATES



- . Nov. 8
 - Detailed floor plans due for exhibitors occupying an island, split island, peninsula, or modified peninsula booth; manufacturers of walk-in coolers, refrigerators and/or freezers; or those with written booth violation notices from 2023
 - · Hanging signs are permitted to a maximum height of 20' to the top of the sign.
